

FLC Confirmation Program

The confirmation program at FLC is for students in Grades 7-9. Regular class nights are held on Wednesday evenings during the school year (September-May).

Occasional sessions are held on Sunday mornings with special guest presenters.

Each confirmation student is matched with an adult mentor from the congregation. Students are encouraged to identify and ask their own mentor - if needed, we will match someone for them. Students affirm their baptism on Confirmation Day (first Sunday in May) in their 9th grade year.

Program Goals

- To deepen the student's relationship with Jesus, with teachers & classmates
- To deepen the student's understanding and participation in worship
- To grow in trust of God's promises
- To grow in knowledge of Lutheran teachings
- To become forces for good in our community & world

Confirmation Expectations

- Faithful and active participate in class
- Worship regularly
- Serve as Acolyte at worship when scheduled
- Serve as worship assistants regularly
- Engage in group service projects
- Engage in total of three service projects per year (1 with mentor)
- Attend regular youth church events
- Confirmation Camp summer between 7th & 8th grade
- SWMN Synod Junior High Youth Gathering November of each year
